SPOT THE COMMON SIGNS OF ABUSE:

- OBVIOUS MALNOURISHMENT OR FATIGUE
- STEALING/BEGGING FOR FOOD
- POOR PERSONAL HYGIENE/TORN, DIRTY CLOTHES
- UNTREATED MEDICAL NEEDS
- FREQUENT ABSENCES/TRUANCY
- UNEXPLAINED INJURIES
- CHANGES IN BEHAVIOR, SUCH AS EXTREME ANGER OR EXCESSIVE CRYING
- EXCESSIVE FEAR OF GOING HOME OR OF A PARENT OR CAREGIVER

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- BE OBSERVANT AND REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOR
- BE A SAFE PERSON TO TALK TO
- BE SUPPORTIVE AND NONJUDGMENTAL
- KEEP NEUTRAL/CALM BODY LANGUAGE AND TONE IF A CHILD DISCLOSES TO YOU
- IF A CHILD DISCLOSES ABUSE, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO INVESTIGATE AND REFER TO PROPER AGENCIES
