We have many preventive measures in place to mitigate mishaps; our leadership must be engaged and vigilant to ensure a professional commitment to our safety culture. It is our collective duty to identify and mitigate hazardous situations and conditions. We will not ignore them.

Safety and risk management allow us to train hard, enjoy off-duty time, and continue to accomplish our mission. The positive influence of a safe culture demonstrates leadership commitment to taking care of Marines. We WILL take care of all of our people through this positive influence by integrating safety in all that we do.
